NOTE:

Incidental food sales occur in many businesses within Sutter County. Sutter County Environmental Health Division does not have the resources to regulate all establishments which conduct incidental food sales. Therefore, Sutter County Environmental Health shall not actively enforce the requirements of the California Retail Food Facilities Law upon establishments conducting incidental food sales when only non-potentially hazardous, prepackaged, ready to eat foods are sold. Such foods include chips, pretzels, soda, and candy. Other food items may be added upon approval by the Environmental Health Division Manager. Foods requiring further processing, even if non-potentially hazardous and prepackaged, shall not be exempted.

A facility shall be considered to have incidental food sales when the total food display and storage area does not exceed 50 square feet or 10% of the total floor space of the facility, whichever is less. Machine vending of non-potentially hazardous, prepackaged, ready to eat foods shall not be included in the determination of food display/storage area.

A person wishing to conduct incidental food sales shall be required to complete an application. A list of those locations conducting incidental food sales shall be maintained to enable monitoring by Sutter County Environmental Health.
