

## THE SUMMER READING CLUB

The Summer Reading Club offers children incentives such as small toys, books and coupons donated by local businesses to encourage continued reading during the summer months. Studies show that children who read 4-6 books during the summer will maintain their reading skills.

Those who do not may fall behind 1-3 months in their reading achievement. When a child signs up for the Summer Reading Club a volunteer at the desk will put his/her name on a game board and file it alphabetically. The child may then begin reading books either here at the library, or at home. When they have finished reading their books they must return to the Summer Reading Club desk and show the books that have been read before returning them. Showing the receipt for checked out books is also acceptable. The volunteers will then stamp the child's card and give them the prize(s) that they have earned. One book equals one stamp. If the child reads larger books, one stamp will be awarded for every 50 pages read. A prize is given for every five stamps earned. Children will be awarded no more than 10 stamps per day. There is no age limit for children who choose to participate in the Summer Reading Program. Children who are too young to read by themselves may be read to by an adult or older sibling to receive stamps.
